(I) Duties and Responsibilities

Under the direct supervision of the Project Head, the Project Manager has the responsibility for leading the entire project. Main responsibilities will include project planning & monitoring, fund utilization monitoring, assessment of activity and report writing. The key responsibilities will be developing the syllabus and content, outreach to schools, communication with stakeholders, conducting sessions at schools, facilitate plastic pick-up from schools and villages, and delivering it to recyclers.
