(I) Duties and Responsibilities

Under the direct supervision of the Project Head, the Project Manager has the responsibility for leading the entire project. Main responsibilities will include project planning, monitoring, fund utilization monitoring, and report writing. The key responsibility will be monitoring of carcasses, monitoring wildlife activity on carcasses, creation of awareness material, analysis of collected data. He/she will lead a team of a Project executive and work with him/her regarding the coordination of various stakeholders' communication, transportation of carcasses, necessary paperwork (on-field, off-field), awareness activities and troubleshooting.

(II) Required Assets (given in the order of importance)

(i) Skills:

- Well-versed with the identification and ecology of vultures, also usage and maintenance of camera traps.
- Builds strong relationships with stakeholders.
- Excellent information technology skills, including word processing, database applications, presentation software, and the internet (MS Excel, PPT, MS Word, etc.)
- Ability to summarize and systematize complex information.
- Report writing (proofs for the same to be provided if asked).
- Responsible, communicative, well-organized, team-oriented person.
- Familiarity with laws related to project work and ethics.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Good organizational and time management skills.
- Ability to work flexible hours as needed.
- Ability to work under very tight deadlines.
- Ability to deliver when working under pressure and within changing circumstances.
- Ability to express ideas clearly; to work independently and in a team.
- Ability to understand your strengths and weaknesses and utilize them to the optimum.
